Are you part of an NHS-led Partner Collaborative?

- If yes, what is the name of the Partner Collaborative?

- If no, are there any future plans to be part of an NHS-led Partner Collaborative?

For the purposes of this request, I refer to an NHS-led Partner Collaborative as per the NHS England's definition; 'A group of providers of specialised mental health, learning disability and autism services who have agreed to work together to improve the care pathway for their local population.'

Humber Teaching NHS Foundation Trust is the Lead Provider within the Humber Coast and Vale Specialised Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism Provider Collaborative – the Trust leads on all 3 work streams – adult secure, adult eating disorder in-patient and CAMHS in-patient.

As at 12 February 2021 the Provider Collaborative has yet to go live and so currently Specialised Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism commissioning and contractual responsibility remains with NHS England.

All health and social care providers within the Humber Coast and Vale area are partners within the Provider Collaborative, however not all provide Specialised Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism services and consequently our Specialised Mental Health, Learning Disability and Autism provider partners are:

Humber Teaching NHS Foundation Trust – Adult Secure and CAMHS
Leeds and York Partnership NHS Foundation Trust – Adult Secure and CAMHS
The Priors – Stockton Hall – Adult Secure
Newbridge Care – Schoen Clinic, York – Adult Eating Disorder In-Patient
NAVIGO – Adult Eating Disorder In-Patient.
