Further to your Freedom of Information Request, please find the Trust's response below:

I'm writing to you under the Freedom of Information Act to request the following data please:

- 1) Does the Trust have a specialist ADHD service for adults? If yes, can you give details please?

Humber Teaching NHS Foundation Trust ("the Trust") delivers an ADHD Assessment and Treatment service for adults with a Hull GP.

- 2) Once a patient is referred to Adult ADHD services, what's the target time for them to be seen for their first assessment?

As this service is currently provided on a cost per case basis, there is no required target time for a first assessment appointment although the service makes every effort to see those patients referred as soon as possible.

- 3) Once a patient is referred to Adult ADHD services, what is the average time they are on a waiting list before their first assessment?

The Trust's average wait time in 2019 for the adult ADHD service was 111 days.

Can you provide the three longest periods of time a patient spent on the waiting list before their first assessment in 2019 and their gender please.

The Trust longest wait times for assessment in 2019 were as follows:

195 days (Male)  
182 days (Male)  
181 days (Male)

- 4) How many patients are currently on the Adult ADHD services waiting list?

As at March 2020, the Trust has 50 waiting assessments in the Adult ADHD Team.
